His job was to watch after his employees in the confined space and shouldn't need to worry about who would walk by the job, passing through a yellow barricade that had a different designation. The Operation Manager demanded the job be done with a yellow barricade tape or he would not sign the confined space entry permit. Ronnie continued to challenge the Operation Manager. The job was questioned on site with employees and this type of job will now be required to have RED barricade tape.
